WASTING TIME

ne morning I was sitting in the blue chair I always sit in, saying my prayers. I looked up from my iPad and out in the water I saw a dolphin pod coming in from the ocean. Maybe they were following a school of fish or maybe they were just checking out the neighborhood. I couldn't tell but what I could tell was that they were enjoying each other's company. They were almost playful in the ways they came up above the surface and then descending back underwater, not all at the same time like a chorus line, more like acrobatic tumblers in a circus. I watched them as long as they were in sight.

I am currently reading "The Art of the Wasted Day" by Patricia Hampl, a beautiful writer from St. Paul who is also a Catholic. The cover flap describes the book as "a picaresque travelogue of leisure written from a lifelong enchantment with solitude." We live in a world of many activities, "To Do" lists to accomplish and chores to be completed. If by some miracu-

lous grace, we get all these done, we feel a bit guilty. "I must be forgetting something I need to do," I mutter to myself. Such a life is all surface and no depth. To find the depth you have to meditate on and contemplate your own life, things which appear in a busy life to be a waste of time.

The Sunday readings we use at Mass are organized on a three-year cycle. Every third year a preacher is confronted by exactly the same readings, something that has happened to me thirteen times. I sometimes read over the readings for the upcoming Sunday and wonder what else I can say about these same readings. If I sit with them long enough, they begin to reveal themselves to me. This is especially true of the passages of scripture that are poetry or narrative. Every good story deserves repeating. Of course, when I come back to certain readings, I have three years more of experiences; the readings may be the same, but I am different, so I often see them differently. That allows me to see

what I have missed in earlier readings; they can remind me of things I've read or seen or a conversation I had with someone.

The same can happen with memories. An event I interpreted one way when it happened to me can look quite different all these years later. I considered a scripture study I taught a few years after I was ordained, a great success then; lots of people attended and what I had to say was much appreciated. But now I think I talked too much and listened too little. They got the Gospel of Luke According to Father Mike. They probably would have learned more if

they engaged with the passages more themselves. The Gospel of Luke According to Their Own Burning Hearts.

I waste time thinking of my relationship with friends, especially those that have died, what they meant to me and mean still, what I loved in them and learned from them, but, most important, the life we shared. I remember the night I stayed up with a classmate; we

were newly ordained then and had lots of thoughts and feelings to sort out. Besides the pastoral work, we had to learn how to work and live with other priests and it was turning out more complicated than we had imagined it would be when we were inexperienced seminarians. The session ended abruptly when one of us saw how very late it was and we both remembered that we were assigned to the early morning Mass in our respective parishes. I was exhausted the next day but not sorry I had stayed up so late. It had been a good conversation.

I am not yet ready to write my memoir. I still look forward now more than I look back. Yet with the help of Patricia Hampl, I am learning the fine art of wasting time, and I find it to be right up my alley.
