CHORES

Like I said, there's always some chore that needs doing. And you find that there are more than a few than you have forgotten you had to do.

That inspires me to think of heaven, which is sometimes called "eternal repose." There will be no more chores in heaven. That's perfectly fine with me. I look forward to it; perhaps then I'll finally get caught up on my reading.

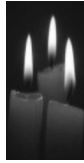
