Both as a seminarian and a priest I have served in nine different parishes. All provide Mass and the sacraments for their parishioners and develop a sense of community, like every other parish, but each in its own way. I was at St. Joachim's at a time when the Mesa part of Costa Mesa had a fast-growing Spanish-speaking

population. Most of the parishes provided Mass in two different languages, some in three. At Saint Irenaeus Mass was celebrated in English, Spanish and Vietnamese and it was a steep learning curve for me to learn the dynamics of each community. Each month I celebrated one Sunday Mass in Spanish with very mixed



results; if I could keep my confidence up, I'd be fine but a few mistakes in pronunciation at the start would shake my confidence and I made more mistakes. I also served on the diocesan level as Director of Family Life, Vicar for Priests and Vicar General. In other words, I've see a lot of the vitality and struggles of Catholics in Orange County.

One of the places I served was the other Saint Anne, in Santa Ana. Those attending the 8:00 or the 10:00 Masses this Sunday will hear their children's choir singing and the principal, Sr. Teresa, giving us a taste for the vital ministry of their school. Thanks for your support for the second collection for St. Anne School.

Last weekend we kicked off the Pastoral Services Appeal (PSA), the annual appeal of the Orange Catholic Foundation that raises funds to provide financial support for selected diocesan pastoral ministries and services. BLESSING OF THROATS

Please join us for mass on Saturday, February 3rd, the feast day of Saint Blaise, for the Blessing of the Throats. Saint Blaise was a bishop in Armenia during the 4th century. According to various accounts he was a physician before becoming a bishop. His cult spread in the Middle Ages because he was reputed to have miraculously cured a little boy who nearly died because of a fishbone in his throat. From the 8th century he has been invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illnesses of the throat.
