
Thank God for the cell phone. It

Following the guidance of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles (our Metropolitan See), effective Tuesday evening, March 17, 2020, public Masses are hereby suspended in the Diocese of Orange.

CHURCH CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC

As public places, our churches will need to close to public entry until further notice per the Governor's order. This will include conducting baptisms (unless in an emergency), weddings, receptions, events, groups, societies, devotions, choirs, funeral vigils, rosaries, and anything that causes people to gather in one place. The anointing of the sick with proper precautions is to be continued. Funerals should be postponed if possible.

This combination was quite common before chemical treatments, as clover keeps your yard looking green during dry periods and produces nitrogen to help fertilize your soil. It also helps keep other weeds at bay and feeds our beloved bees!
