STRESS

These are not normal times and so we may need to do something more to address our current situation.

First, talk to someone. Tell that person how you have been affected by the quarantine, which can include depression and anxiety about the fact that the virus is microscopic and thus cannot be seen with the naked eye and avoided. When you go to the market to shop for groceries, you do not know who many of your fellow shoppers are or what their medical condition might be. You worry that maybe you are not following the guidelines closely enough, opening yourself to contagion.

Despite what you have said or done or not said or not done, the virus is not your fault. And if you talk about it to someone else, you might find that the journey may well be easier. Nothing is more dangerous than being anxious alone and obsessing over the dangers in your mind over and over. Also, choose *one* of our news sources to keep you abreast of the latest: CNN, BBC, CBS, ABC, NBC, FOXNEWS or one of the daily newspapers. Watching them all will likely increase your anxiety.

Second, consider deep, slow breathing, in and out. This can slow down your anxiety and give you a better sense of being grounded. This is especially helpful when you think about what had happened and then what might still happen. Think of it as clearing your mind.

Third, although these are difficult times, there is also many positive things happening in the world, not the least of all that families are helping families, neighbors are helping neighbors, our peace officers, doctors and health professionals remain at the ready, despite the increased danger to them. And don't forget the farmers, some of whom have

no way to get their harvest to market and may well lose

their farms.

Pray more than the usual. Give thanks for all who are out there protecting you to the best of their ability. Give thanks for your faith that allows you to call upon the Almighty at this time of vulnerability. Sometimes at times like this when our minds may be hard to focus, prayers like the rosary and other prayers that we have

memorized may help us to pray. And if these dangers cause you to doubt God's presence and love, ask God for the faith you need to battle through your fears and doubts. Our Lady is known under many titles but I suspect Our Lady of Refuge could be an excellent choice in our prayers that call for her intercession. Think of yourself in her embrace.




