## PSALM 10 (Part I)


As a diocesan priest I am required to pray at various times each day for the people of God by using the Liturgy of the Hours, also known as “the Office.” When I first started praying it in the seminary, I liked it when we prayed, “The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.” It wasn’t exactly true; the Lord was my/our shepherd but I was still filled with relationships, plans and circumstances I *wanted* to work out. But lots of the other psalms seemed to be about circumstances that I, as a comfortable seminarian with plenty to eat and drink and a roof over my head, and lots that showed me I was indeed quite blessed.

What was I to make of Psalm 10, prayed by someone who was in trouble? He or she complains: “Why, LORD, do you stand afar and pay no heed in times of trouble?” The psalmist is not the only one in trouble: “Arrogant scoundrels pursue the poor; they trap them by their cunning schemes.”

The arrogance of those in high social position who oppress others is what depresses the Psalmist. “The wicked even boast of their greed; these robbers curse and scorn the LORD.”

Part of the Psalmist's complaint is that the wicked are giving his/her own God a bad name: “In their insolence the wicked boast: ‘God does not care; there is no God.’” The

psalmist wants to know: Why isn’t God hammering these wicked, arrogant so-and-sos? “Their affairs always succeed [though] they ignore your judgment on high; they sneer at all who oppose them.”

Then the Psalmist specifies the charges against his enemies: “Their mouths are full of oaths, violence, and lies; discord and evil are under their tongues. They wait in ambush near towns; their eyes watch for the helpless to murder the innocent in secret; they lurk in ambush like lions in a thicket, hide there to trap the poor, snare them and close the net. The helpless are crushed, laid low; they fall into the power of the wicked, who say in their hearts, ‘God has forgotten, shows no concern, never bothers to look.’”

The disciples of their God feel abandoned. Has God gone onto a vacation to Tahiti at this critical hour? The Psalmist tries to motivate God to act: “Rise up, LORD! God, lift up your hand! Do not forget the poor!”

The Psalmist does not believe the boast of his/her enemy and af-

firms his/her trust in God: “But you do see; you take note of misery and sorrow; you take the matter in hand. To you the helpless can entrust their cause; you are the defender of orphans.”

 Amen.


