BOOKS, part three

Brian Doyle was the longtime editor of Portland Magazine in Oregon and, like Flannery O'Connor, died in his prime, 60 years of age. He was the author of six collections of essays, two nonfiction books, two collections of prose poems, a short story collection, a novella, and four novels. "We're only here for a minute," he once said.

"We're here for a little window. And to use that time to catch and share shards of light and laughter and grace seems to me the great story." I suggest you start with *Grace Notes*.



Colum McCann's *Let the Great World Spin* is an American masterpiece, a dazzling and hauntingly rich vision of the loveliness, pain, and mystery of New York City in the 1970s. In the dawning light of a late summer morning, the people of lower Manhattan stood hushed, staring up in disbelief at the Twin Towers. It was August, 1974, and a tightrope walker is running, dancing, leaping between the towers, suspended a quar-

ter-mile in the sky, a true life event. This novel describes how it changed the lives of those who had witnessed it. "The world spins. We stumble on. It is enough."

Msgr. Tomáš Halík is a Czech Roman Catholic priest, philosopher, and theologian. His books are about religion and spirituality. He is a recipient of the Templeton Prize which celebrates scientific and spiritual curiosity. The book I really like is *Patience with God*. "Believers and unbelievers are not two clearly separate groups like two soccer teams" he said. "The playing field for the contest between belief and unbelief is within each individual human heart and human mind."



My favorite Halik quote: "If you come across a rabbit playing Mozart on the violin, you can bet your bottom dollar that the rabbit is acting supernaturally. Rabbits have not got it in them to play the violin. Moreover, things being the way they are with human sinfulness, if you come across human beings acting with consistent kindness, selflessness, and generosity, the same assumption is in order."

EUCARISTIC EXPOSITION



“Exposition of the Holy Eucharist leads us to acknowledge Christ’s marvelous presence in the sacrament and invites us to the spiritual union with him that culminates in sacramental communion” (Ceremonial, 1102).

Exposition is offered in the Church at 8 AM every Friday with Benediction at 8:50 AM. As required by health directives, since it is inside, singing by a leader is permitted but not by the congregation. Prayers may be recited by persons with masks.

ALL SOULS



The plenary indulgence for those who visit a cemetery and pray for the deceased is available throughout the entire month of November.

The All Souls Day indulgence for those who visit a church or oratory, praying the Our Father and the Creed is available all month.

The elderly and those not able to leave their homes may obtain the indulgence by praying for the dead in front of an image of Jesus or the Blessed Mother.

Note that the other conditions (sacramental confession, reception of Holy Communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father) should be completed as soon as possible.

The Apostolic Penitentiary, “prays heartily that all priests equipped with the opportune faculties, may offer themselves with particular generosity to the celebration of the Sacrament of Penance and administer Holy Communion to the sick.”
