PATRON SAINTS

From the earliest days of the Church, groups of the faithful (families, communities, regions, countries) have chosen a deceased and particularly holy person intercede for them with God. Seeking the intercession of a patron saint does not mean that one cannot approach God directly in prayer; rather, it's like asking a friend to pray for you, while you also pray—except the friend is already in heaven, and can pray to God without ceasing. It's the communion of saints; here are some interesting patrons:

SURFING: St. Christopher is the patron saint of travel and travelers, and the reach of his patronage is wide—from mariners and sailors to mountaineers and drivers. St. Christopher medals were originally worn by seafaring folk for safe passage, and in the 1960s the medals were lovingly adopted by the surfing community.

FAMILIES: Not all saints lived tranquil lives. St. Eugene de Mazenod grew up with parents who fought constantly with interference from his grandmother and a neurotic maternal aunt. His parents' eventual divorce was very unusual for the late 18th century. That and the French Revolution left him mostly on his own, growing up amid the idle rich. He had a mystical experience at the foot of a cross on Good Friday 1807, after which he became a priest, ministered to the sick, prisoners, the poor and the overlooked young, and went on to found a religious order.

COOKS: Saint Lawrence was one of seven deacons under Pope St. Sixtus. He was condemned to death by the Prefect of Rome. The story goes that as he was being grilled, he called out to those torturing him saying, "Turn me over I'm done on this side!" And just before he died, he said, "It's cooked enough now."

STUDENTS: Peter of Alexandria headed its catechetical school before he was named bishop-patriarch in 300. Eusebius called Peter an excellent teacher. Peter's own theological writings were cited in a fifth-century dispute over Christ's divinity and humanity. His instructions on how to receive "lapsed" Christians (those who had denied their faith) back into the Church were adopted by the entire Eastern Church. For much of his episcopate he encouraged his peo-

ple to remain Christian in the face of Emperor Diocletian's persecutions; when a new emperor renewed Christian persecutions he went into hiding. But eventually he was seized and executed.

INTERNET: Carlo Acutis, an Italian schoolboy who helped spread Roman Catholic teaching online before he died of leukemia in 2006, is a candidate to become the protector of web surfers. He used his coding skills to launch webpages for many priests and parishes. A miracle has been attributed to his intercession so he will be beatified on October 10th, the first step toward canonization.

PARENTS AND GRANDPARENTS: The grandparents of our Lord, Joachim and Anne, greatly wanted to be parents. Both were perplexed, but prayerful, in the face of not being able to have children. Renewing their dedication to God, one day as Anne prayed in the temple and Joachim fasted and prayed in the desert, they both received visions of Archangel Gabriel. Rushing to meet each other, they realized that the joyous news had been given to both of them at the same time. They became the parents of Mary.

FISHERMEN: Peter was from the town of Bethsaida by the Sea of Galilee. He worked as a fisherman with his brother Andrew before meeting Jesus. St. Peter became one of Jesus' first apostles after a miracle known as "The Miraculous Catch of Fish." They had been sitting in their boat and listening to Jesus preach on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. After he finished, Jesus called to Peter on his boat and told him to lower his nets into the water. Peter was hesitant but when the nets were lowered into the water, he suddenly felt a great weight in the net. There were 153 fish in his net, such a massive number that he needed help from other boats to drag them all onboard. He was martyred died by crucifixion (with arms outstretched) in the year 64. This took place three months after the disastrous fire that destroyed Rome for which the Emperor Nero wished to blame the Christians.


