JOURNEYS

These have been lonely months in lockdown. I did not take my summer vacation. Where could I have gone?

So I have made due by watching travel shows on the Travel Channel, Discovery and PBS: *Planet Earth*, *Rick Steve's Europe*, *The Travel Show*, *Our Planet* with David Attenborough and reruns of Anthony Bourdain's *Parts Unknown*. My favorites are those that visit places I know, in my dotage, I'll never go. Antarctica? No thank you. This program is as close as I ever want to get.

My current reading also takes me away: Marilynne Robinson's *Jack* (all of her novels, including this one, take place in the fictional Iowa town of Gilead.) Luis Alberto Urrea's *House of Broken Angels* (about the border between Mexico and the U.S.) Waiting me on my coffee table are Olaf Olafsson's *The Sacrament* (which is set mostly in Iceland) and Mphuthumi Ntabeni's *The Broken River Tent* (set in the 19th century eastern cape of South Africa.)

The most interesting book I read recently was Nicolas Diat's *A Time to Die*. Diat, a French journalist, takes as his premise that, among other things, monks enter monasteries to prepare for death. So he goes to Benedictine, Cistercian and Trappist monks as well as to canons and Norbertines to gather their thoughts about death in order to discover the greatest mystery of all—the end of life.

Of course, this ultimate journey lies ahead for all of us and no book or

show can takes its place. I am speaking, of course, experiencing what lies beyond. Some people fear it because they are afraid of what God will say in judgement against them; since it lasts for eternity, you don't want to find you have a reservation in that other place. But I am kinda looking forward to it, though I am not in a hurry to get there. This current creation is so impressive, (the Sequoias, Handel's Messiah, the smell of a good cabernet sauvignon, the softness of cat fur, the sweetness of handmade vanilla ice cream, to name but a few) that we've relish it.

Think of heaven as the next great adventure: getting to meet your favorite saints, reuniting with parents and loved ones, seeing in person a real angel, not to mention touring the "many rooms of our Father's house," which I suspect is a lot like visiting Heart Castle but much more magnificent. In *Love Medicine*, Louise Erdrich asks provocatively, "How come we've

got these bodies? They are frail support for what we feel. There are times I get so hemmed in by my own arms and legs I look forward to getting past them. As though death will set me free like a traveling cloud....I'll be out there as a piece of endless body of the world feeling pleasures so much larger than skin and bones and blood."

Albert Camus, the great existentialist philosopher, put it most positively, "The great courage is still to gaze as squarely at the light as at death."




Pastoral Care:
