Mission: Do Campus Plan Now

Pastoral Effectiveness:

- Long overdue for purposely-designed Priest Residences for our clergy active and retired—to live in community
 - ...healthy, safe and secure residence with room enough for all clergy, for many years to come
- > More Campus facilities to support **Spiritual Growth** & **Faith Formation**
- **Temporal Assets**: Current buildings are very old ... and already over capacity
 - Offices were built 87 years ago as single-story, wood frame house
 - Priest Residences were built 81 years ago as single-story, beach cottages
 - Hall was built **58** years ago as a single-story building, with movable partitions

*... and we have the **Pastoral leadership** that is needed for this project



Campus Plan: Overall Scope, Schedule & Cost

- Phase 1: Entitlement Processing & Schematic Design (in progress)
 - √ \$616,000 budget / start August 2024
- Phase 2: Building Permits, Design Development & Construction Documents
 - √ \$1,538,000 budget / start April 2027
- Phase 3: Construction & Construction Management
 - √ \$17,000,000 budget / start March 2028
- **Phase 4**: Furniture, Furnishings & Equipment / Project Closeout

√ \$538,000 budget / start February 2029



Construction Fundraising: \$17 million Goal

1. Campus Plan Construction. The Campus Plan for Saint Anne Catholic Church is a project to take place on the current holistic church campus to replace existing buildings with four new buildings-Chapel, Parish Hall, Parish Offices, and Priest Residences-as well as to renovate the parking lot for more parking, but not to make any construction changes to our beloved, 88-year old Mission Revival Style Church. This Campus Plan is forecast to begin construction in April 2028 and to take 2-years to complete construction of all four new buildings. The result will be a church campus that continues as a sacred place of simple beauty, welcoming the faithful for many generations at this landmark parish in Old Town Seal Beach.

2. Donor Intent. The intent of pledges and gifts to the Campus Plan at Saint Anne Catholic Church is to fund construction in the Campus Plan of four new buildings-Chapel, Parish Hall, Parish Offices, and Priest Residences—shown in the renderings above, along with additional parking and disabled access parking. If a change in plans results in gifts to the Campus Plan not being used for the Donor Intent described in this Pledge Statement, then individual donors shall have the right to request their gift be returned to them.

- 3. Fundraising Mission. The mission of the Faithful In Every Generation construction fundraising is to raise seventeen million dollars (\$17,000,000) for construction in the Campus Plan. The Pledge Amount for the Campus Plan shall be pledged by December 31, 2025.
- 4. Four Year Gift Payments, While Gift Payments are welcomed during 2025, Gift Payments are expected to be made over four years' time in 2026, 2027, 2028 & 2029, so the total Pledge Amount is completed by December 31, 2029. Also, the goal is at least one-fourth of the Pledge Amount be received as checks and/or strategic donations in each of the years 2026, 2027, 2028 & 2029.

All Gift Payments shall be deposited in savings account St. Anne Church (SB) Campus Plan (SAV) ("Campus Plan Fund"), at Farmers & Merchants Bank. As the balance increases in the Campus Plan Fund, but before expenditures are made for construction costs, it is possible for funds to be transferred to a secured investment account at Christian Brothers Investment Services, Inc.

5. Designation for Pledges. This is the designation for Pledge Amounts to the Campus Plan:

Pledge of more than \$2,000,000 A Gift of Faith Pledge between \$1,000,000 up to \$1,999,999 . . . A Gift of Hope Pledge between \$500,000 up to \$999,999 A Gift of Love Pledge between \$100,000 up to \$499,999 A Gift of Grace Pledge between \$50,000 up to \$99,999 A Gift of Wisdom Pledge between \$5,000 up to \$49,999 A Gift of Prayer Pledge between \$1,000 up to \$4,999 A Gift of Peace

A future Donor Wall, in recognition of gifts received, shall use this Designation for Pledges.

6. Participating in Naming Opportunities. In consideration of pledges of extraordinary generosity, there is the opportunity to leave a lasting legacy by participating in the name that applies to each new building, which is done in collaboration with parish and diocese officials:

Pledge of \$2,500,000	Participation in Naming the Parish Hall
Pledge of \$2,000,000	Participation in Naming the Parish Offices
Pledge of \$2,000,000	Participation in Naming the Priest Residences
Pledge of \$1,500,000	Participation in Naming the Chapel

7. Recognition for Fourteen Largest Pledges. For donors that make a pledge prior to December 31, 2025, donors for the fourteen (14) largest pledges will be invited by Father John to join Via Crucis Guild, in recognition of their major donor pledges.

Membership in the Via Crucis Guild includes the donor's household name being associated with one of the new Stations of the Cross, currently under custom design and production. These new Stations of the Cross are planned for Church installation during Lent 2026.
